Glencairn	≥ \$5000	The 14th Earl of Glencairn , was a Scottish nobleman, soldier and patron of Burns. He secured success with the printing of Burns second edition of poetry, the Edinburgh Edition.	Sponsorship at this level includes attendance for you and up to 3 Guests to the President's Reception.
Graham	≥ \$2500	Robert Graham of Fintry, recommended Burns for a position with his Majesty's Customs & Excise, thus allowing earning him a regular income and support his family.	Sponsorship at this level includes attendance for you and up to 3 Guests to the President's Reception.
